Committee reviewed the Terms of Reference, taking into account decisions made by Council and resolved to accept the changes (with the appropriate re-numbering), with the exception of item "To work with partners to address the implications to the community of Houses in Multiple Occupations (HiMOS)". Committee resolved to recommend to Council that this item be retained within the Terms of Reference.

**31/17 Links with Local Councils in The Gambia**

Committee considered a possible link with Local Councils in The Gambia and resolved that Cllr Oguntola be tasked to investigate links and opportunities, including links between Schools, on her next trip to The Gambia and report back to Committee with the findings.

- 32/17 Volunteering Opportunities via Equality Council UK – Annexe B**  
Committee considered how the Parish Council could work with the Equality Council UK, to support them to offer residents from minority groups, the opportunity to volunteer as part of a number of local & national initiatives and resolved to invite them to attend the Picnics and also to recommend to Communications Committee that we share the advertising of the opportunities available on the Parish Website and in Homeground.
- 33/17 Play Area Improvements Update**  
Committee noted that Cllrs Dicerbo, Oguntola and May met with MK Council to discuss initial ideas for Play Area Improvements in Willen and Springfield – subject to a successful Play Area Improvement Fund application. Outline costings are awaited and Committee will be presented with a report when the outcomes are known.
- Committee resolved that Cllrs Halton-Davis, Dicerbo and Kendrick arrange to meet with Honda to investigate any possibilities for their involvement in a Multi Use Games Area (MUGA) project within the Parish

- 34/17 Battle’s Over – A Nation’s Tribute – Annexe C**  
Committee considered whether the Parish Council could get involved with the event to commemorate and remember the end of the war and those killed and wounded. The event will see beacons throughout the UK lit at 7pm on 11 November 2018. Committee resolved to recommend to Council that the Parish be part of this event and make arrangements for the beacon at Campbell Park to be lit.

Committee discussed the idea of asking schools to design signs that could be put up outside the school. Committee resolved that Cllr Halton-Davis should ascertain what support is sought from the Parish Council and invite Mr Neale to attend the next Committee meeting.
