

Campbell Park Parish Council submitted its draft Neighbourhood Plan to Milton Keynes Council, in accordance with Regulation 15 of the Neighbourhood Plans (General) Regulations 2012. Milton Keynes Council now has to publish the neighbourhood plan for a period of consultation after which the Plan and any comments received will be considered by an independent planning examiner.

The Campbell Park Neighbourhood Plan will therefore be **available for comments** for six weeks between **Wednesday 14th February and Wednesday 28th March, 2018**.

Following this publication stage, Milton Keynes Council will pass any comments received to an independent person who will examine the plan and consider whether the plan has met the basic conditions for a neighbourhood plan; that it satisfies the legal requirements for a neighbourhood plan; and to identify an appropriate area for the referendum. As part of that process, the Examiner will decide if the plan should proceed to the Referendum stage, where local residents will have the opportunity to vote on whether the Campbell Park Neighbourhood Plan should be 'adopted' by Milton Keynes Council, and used in the determination of planning applications in the area.
