INTRODUCTION

To achieve our ambitions for Campbell Park, the Parish Council wants to work closely with the public - residents, communities, businesses and voluntary organisations. Our aim is to engage with our residents to encourage their participation in decision making, securing better services, being engaged with the local democratic process and creating a more active and informed community.

AIMS

The Parish Council aims to undertake the following:

To enable residents to become involved, empowered and active through:

- The involvement of residents in the development of a Parish Appraisal

- Seeking the views of all age groups particularly the elderly and young people
- Active engagement with residents through questionnaires and consultations on specific issues.

To communicate information to the community clearly, factually and appropriately through:

- The Council's websites which detail all council services and activities
- A quarterly newsletter sent out to every household
- The use of plain English with minimum jargon
- The adherence to a corporate design/logo
- The sharing of information via Social Media channels

To improve our communication with our partners and stakeholders and coordinate our community engagement efforts through:

 Being actively involved in various networking organisations (e.g. the Milton Keynes Association of Urban Local Councils, the Parish Assembly

To raise the image and reputation of the Council through:

- Inviting residents to be actively involved in our meetings
- Publicising widely the Annual Parish Meeting
- Encouraging usage of the Council's websites
- Inviting residents/community groups to provide information for the Council Newsletter
- Issuing press releases covering activities of the Council
- Encouraging the Chairman and all Councillors to actively represent the community

To enable every Councillor to maximise their role as elected representatives and Community Leaders through:

- Uploading of agendas & minutes on the Council website
- Encouraging Councillors to attend meetings of community organisations and residents' associations in their respective wards
- Encouraging Councillors to take up places on community groups and organisations

To ensure every member of staff understands the Council's priorities through:

- Having regular staff appraisals
- Staff to provide information and advice to Councillors as and when required
- Encouraging staff to actively represent the interests of the Parish Council at community events
