Committee received a presentation on the project from John Best and Jane Wolfson.

Following some discussion about ways in which CPPC could work in partnership with BMKWT on this project for the benefit of residents, Committee considered the

draft partnership framework, proposed by BMKWT. This includes a commitment for CPPC to provide funding over a minimum of 3 years as well as resources to enable the implementation of the Parish projects.

Committee resolved to revisit the proposal at the next meeting, with Members agreeing to give this further thought and come to next meeting with ideas for potential projects.

# 68/20 Community Basketball Coaching Summer Programme

Committee considered a proposal to support MK Community Basketball Club to host basketball sessions in Oldbrook, as part of their summer programme, for local young people.

Committee resolved to support the proposal, with a commitment to providing the  $\pounds 200$  sponsorship required for this to be delivered in the Parish, with the court off Boycott Avenue in Oldbrook identified as the best location for this.

## 69/20 Play Area Improvements (minute 57/20, 44ii/20)

Committee noted that Building & Properties Committee have set up a working group which will commence the Pirate Park Under 5's play area project next month.

Committee noted that Cllr Jones had completed an inspection of the fitness equipment at Oldbrook Green with the Committee Clerk obtaining quotations for the required repairs. It was noted that the Committee Clerk and was liaising with MK Council to seek support to address the issues.

Committee noted that the play area surveys are in progress.

#### 70/20 Activity Packs for Children (minute 58/20)

Committee considered a draft budget for the production of Activity Packs for each school holiday in 2021/22 and resolved to approve the budget of £1800, as proposed, to be allocated from the Social Cohesion budget.

Committee also received an update on the plans for the Easter Activity Packs, which would be available for collection from 4 pickup points from Friday 26<sup>th</sup> March. The Committee Clerk to contact all schools (except Willen) to share the advert for the packs. An advert will also be placed on our Social Media Channels. Cllr Dixon will share the advertising across the various Willen community Facebook groups etc.
