i. **Grant Budget 2022/23**

The Committee Clerk gave a verbal report to the Committee on the latest grant budget report detailing the funds available for the rest of this financial year.

- ii. **Keech Hospice** (Grant Application 009/22-23/Sect 137)
Committee considered an application from Keech Hospice for £500.00 towards specialist care in the community for children with life-limiting conditions.
