63/22 Parish Council Allotments - Site Update Report

The Committee received a verbal update report from the Lead Member for Allotments which covered toilet and water provision to the sites, lease renewals and the advertisement of plot availability in Homeground magazine.

64/22 Community Centre Hire Charge – Potential Additional Energy Cost Surcharge

The Committee noted that confirmation had been given that community centres are included in the government energy bill relief scheme (EBRS), which will offset some of previously anticipated energy cost increases. Further information is being collated to assess the impact that the EBRS will have on community centre energy costs to March 2023.

The Committee noted that notice had been served to terminate the current agreement for the use of Fishermead Sports Ground by Gallacticos FC at the end of the current football season (31.05.23).
